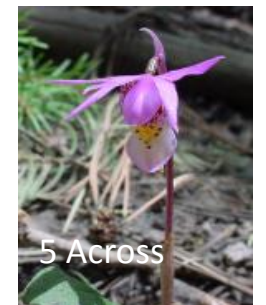
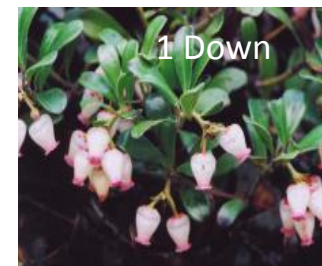
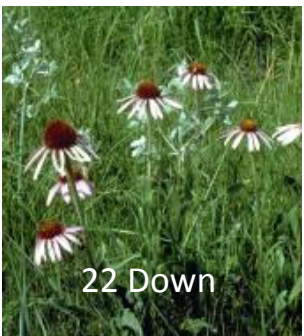
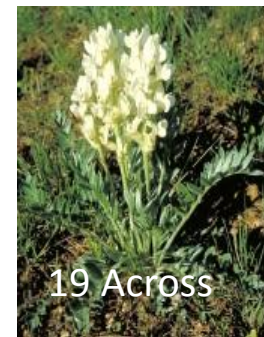
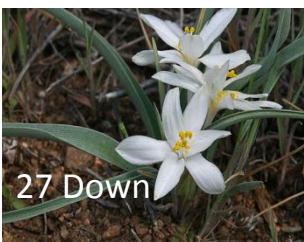


Wyoming Wildflower Crossword Puzzle

How well do you know our native wildflowers? Match the pictures with the names, then fill in the spaces with common names to complete the crossword.





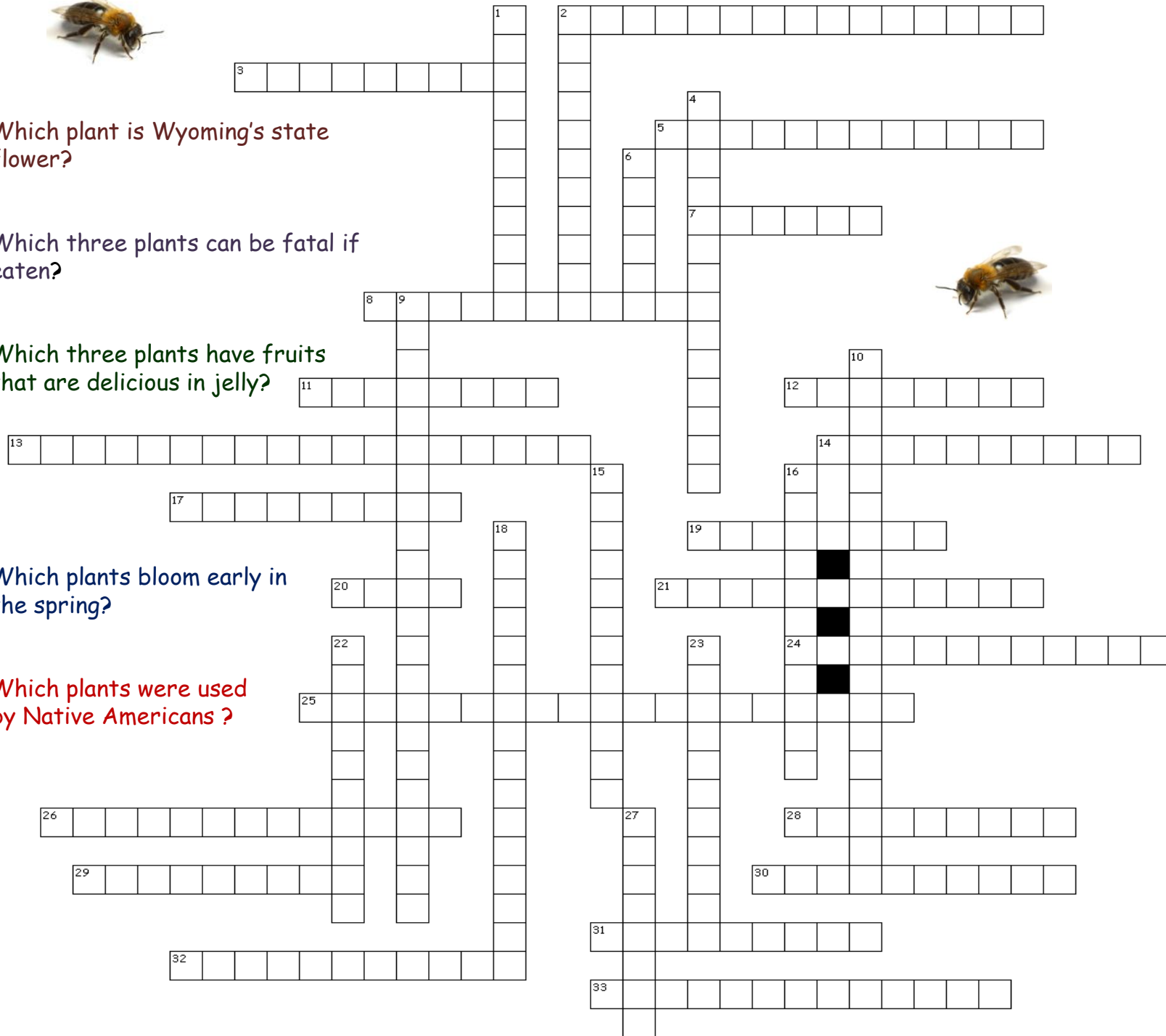
